



# Daisy Birthday

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Daisy Delight (143669); Birthday Delivery (143660)
- **Paper:** Whisper White Cardstock (100730); Daffodil Delight Cardstock (119683); Night of Navy Cardstock (100867); Delightful Daisy Designer Series Paper (144137)
- **Inks:** Daffodil Delight Classic Stampin' Pad (126944); Night of navy Classic Stampin' Pad (126970)
- **Embellishments:** 1/4" Double-Stitched Ribbon – Daffodil Delight (144116)
- **Adhesives:** Dimensionals (104430); SNAIL Adhesive (104332); Glue Dots (103683);
- **Other:** Daisy Punch (143713); 3/4" Circle Punch (119873); Stitched Shapes Framelits (145372); Big Shot Die-Cutting Machine (143263)

## Measurements:

- **Night of Navy:** 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" card base (portrait – scored at top)
- **Whisper White:** 3" x 4" layer; 2-3/4" x 2-3/4" layer; 5-1/4" x 4" inside layer; small scrap
- **Daffodil Delight:** 2-1/2" x 5"
- **Delightful Daisy DSP:** 2-1/2" x 4" layer

Instructions:

1. Cut and score all paper as outlined above.
2. Use Snail along the bottom edge of front of the white layer to attach the DSP about 1/4" up. Wrap ribbon around the seam and attach to the back of the layer using glue dots. Use Snail to attach this layer to the card front.
3. Use the largest square Framelit to cut out a square from the square piece of Whisper White. Use Night of Navy ink to stamp the sentiment in lower right corner.
4. Use Daffodil Delight ink to stamp two flowers onto the piece of Daffodil Delight cardstock. Make sure there is a petal pointing straight up and down when you stamp so that it slides into the punch easier. Punch the flowers out. Use a bone folder or pen to gently curl the petals. Use a glue dot to attach the two flowers together. Use navy ink to stamp the flower center onto the small scrap of white paper. Punch out using the 3/4" Circle Punch. Attach to flower with a glue dot.
5. Use a Dimensional to attach to the flower to the white square. Use Dimensionals to attach flower layer to card front.
6. Use Daffodil Delight ink to stamp flowers on the inside layer. Use Night of Navy ink to stamp the flower centers. Use Snail to attach the layer to the inside of the card.
