



# Season of Cheer

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## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Watercolor Christmas (144835/144838 HC)
- **Paper:** Basic Black Cardstock (141045); Whisper White Cardstock (100730); Old Olive Cardstock (100702); Merry Little Christmas Designer Series Paper (144621 HC)
- **Inks:** Basic Black Archival Ink Pad (140931)
- **Embellishments:** Black Rhinestone Jewels (144639 HC); 3/8" Shimmer Ribbon – Basic Black (144129)
- **Adhesives:** Dimensionals (104430); SNAIL Adhesive (104332)
- **Other:** 2" Circle Punch (133782)

## Measurements:

- **Basic Black:** 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" card base (portrait – side fold)
- **Old Olive:** 5-1/4" x 4" layer (cut two)
- **Whisper White:** 2-1/4" x 2-1/4"; 1" scrap; 5" x 3-3/4" layer
- **DSP:** 5" x 3-3/4" layer

Instructions:

1. Cut and score all pieces as outline above.
2. Use black ink to stamp sentiment onto the center of the 2-1/4" white square. Punch out using the circle punch.
3. On small scrap of white, stamp the outline tree graphic. Fussy cut. Place rhinestone in middle.

*Tip: To **Fussy Cut** simply means that you will use your paper snips (small scissors) to cut the tree out leaving very little border around it.*

4. One white layer, stamp a small tree on the bottom right corner. Adhere this layer to one of the Old Olive layers using SNAIL. Attach this layer to inside of card using SNAIL.
5. Use SNAIL to adhere DSP to the other Old Olive layer. Use Dimensionals to attach the circle to the front of this layer and use a Dimensional to attach to the tree next to this circle or on top of it.
6. Tie a length of ribbon around the layer over the top of the circle. Tie bow so that sentiment can still be seen.
7. Use Dimensionals to attach layer to card front.

  
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
