



# Silver Lining

## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Sprinkles of Life (139971)
- **Paper:** Basic Black Cardstock (121045); Whisper White Cardstock (100730); Basic Gray Cardstock (121044); Smoky Slate Cardstock (131202)
- **Inks:** Smoky Slate Classic Stampin' Pad (131179); Basic Black Archival Stampin' Pad (140931); VersaMark (102283)
- **Embellishments:** Silver Stampin' Emboss Powder (109131); Basic Black Baker's Twine (134576); Glitter & Clear Epoxy Shapes (145632 – OCC 2018)
- **Adhesives:** Dimensionals (104430); SNAIL Adhesive (104332);
- **Other:** Tree Builder Punch (138295); Heat Tool (129053); Big Shot Die-Cutting Machine (143263); Garden Trellis Textured Impressions Embossing Folder (143741)

## Measurements:

- **Basic Black:** 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" card base (portrait – scored on top)
- **Whisper White:** 5-1/4" x 4" layer – Cut 2; 3-1/4" x 2-3/4" layer; 3/4" x 3-1/4" banner
- **Basic Gray:** 4" x 3" layer; 1-1/4" x 4-1/2" for clouds
- **Smoky Slate:** 1" x 3-1/2" banner; 1-1/4" x 2-1/4" for cloud

## Instructions:

1. Cut and score all pieces as outline above.
2. Use VersaMark ink to stamp the cloud images on to the gray cardstock. Sprinkle with silver embossing powder and tap off any extra. Use Heat Tool to set powder. When cool, use Tree Builder Punch to punch out the three clouds. Set aside.
3. Run larger white layer through the Big Shot with the Embossing folder. Use SNAIL to adhere this layer to the front of the card.
4. On the smaller white layer, use the rain drops image to stamp rain in Smoky Slate. Adhere the epoxy rain drops over the stamped drops. Use SNAIL to adhere layer to Basic Gray layer.
5. Use Dimensionals to attach clouds to layer – then use Dimensionals to attach layer to card front.
6. Make the banner notches is each of the banner pieces. Use black ink to stamp sentiment on white banner. Use SNAIL to adhere banner layers together. Wrap end of banner with baker's twine and tie in knot. Attach banner to card front using Dimensionals.
7. INSIDE – Use Smoky Slate ink to randomly stamp rain drops on white layer. Use SNAIL to adhere layer to inside of card base.
