Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Sorry for Everything ()
- **Paper:** Whisper White Cardstock (100730); Basic Black Cardstock (121045); Petal Passion Designer Series Paper (145589 – OCC2018)
- **Inks:** Basic Black Archival Stampin' Pad (140931)
- **Embellishments:** Basic Black Baker's Twine (134576)
- **Adhesives:** Dimensionals (104430); SNAIL Adhesive (104332); Glue Dots (103683)
- **Other:** Leaf Punch (144667)

Measurements:

- **Whisper White:** 5-1/2 x 4-1/4" card base – portrait (scored on side); 3-1-4" x 2-3/4" layer
- **Basic Black:** 5-1/4" x 4" layer; 3-3/8" x 2-7/8" layer; scraps for leaves
- **Petal Passion DSP:** 5-3/8" x 3-7/8" layer

Instructions:

1. Cut and score all pieces as outline above.
2. Stamp sentiment on small white layer using black ink. Set aside to dry.
3. Use SNAIL to adhere DSP to larger black layer. Then, use SNAIL to adhere layer to card front.
4. Adhere smaller white layer to smaller black layer using SNAIL.
5. Use Leaf Punch to punch out seven leaves. Use Glue Dots to attach two leaves to front of smaller white layer. Use Glue dots to attach three leaves to the back of this layer as shown in photo. Use Dimensionals to attach layer to card front.
6. Use baker's twine to create a multi-string bow. Use Glue Dot to attach to card front as shown.
7. Use Glue Dots to attach remaining leaves to inside of card.
