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Supplies:

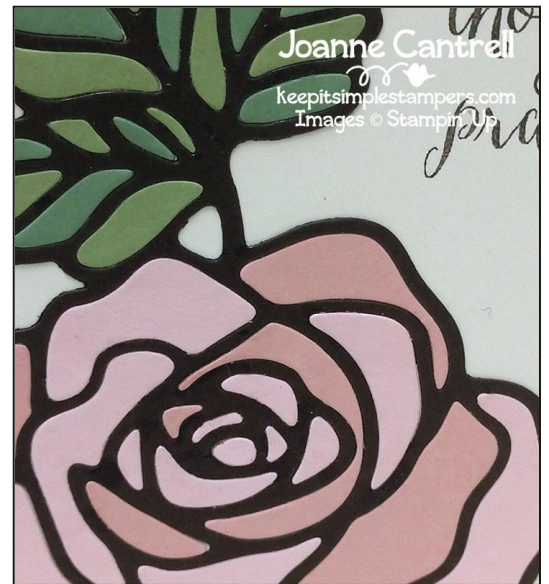
- **Stamp Sets:** Rose Wonder (140697)
- **Paper:** Crumb Cake Cardstock (120953); Early Espresso Cardstock (119686); Very Vanilla Cardstock (101650); Blushing Bride Cardstock (131198); Pink Pirouette Cardstock (111351); Wild Wasabi Cardstock (108641); Pear Pizazz Cardstock (131201)
- **Inks:** Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad (126974); Wild Wasabi Classic Stampin' Pad (126959)
- **Adhesives:** Dimensionals (104430), SNAIL Adhesive (104332), Fine-Tip Glue Pen (138309) or Multipurpose Adhesive Sheets (144106)
- **Other:** Rose Garden Thinlits (140619); Big Shot Die-Cutting Machine (143263); Big Shot Die Brush (144262); Precision Base Plate (139684)

Measurements:

- **Crumb Cake:** 5 ½" x 4 ¼" card base (8 ½" x 5 ½" scored at 4 ¼")
- **Early Espresso:** 5 ¼" x 4"; 3 ½" x 6"
- **Very Vanilla:** 5" x 3 ¾"; 5 ¼" x 4"
- **Pink Pirouette:** 3 ½" x 3 ½"
- **Blushing Bride:** 3 ½" x 3 ½"
- **Wild Wasabi:** 1 ½" x 1 ¼"
- **Pear Pizazz:** 2 ¼" x 2 ¼"; 1 ½" x 1 ¼"

Instructions:

1. Cut and score all pieces as outline above.
 - a. If using adhesive sheets, apply to the back of the 3 ½" x 6" piece of Early Espresso, the 3 ½" x 3 ½" pieces of Blushing Bride and Pink Pirouette, and the 2 ¼" x 2 ¼" and the 1 ½" x 1 ¼" pieces of Wild Wasabi and Pear Pizzazz
2. Cut one rose/leaves using the 3 ½" x 6" piece of Espresso. You will not need the inside pieces of this one but you can save if you want!
3. Cut two roses – once in Pink Pirouette, one in Blushing bride and reserve the pieces. Cut two of each leaves – one using the Wil Wasabi pieces, one using the Pear Pizzazz pieces. Reserve the pieces. (You can save the outer cuts for other cards!)
4. Adhere the espresso flower/leaves to the smaller of the Very Vanilla layers. Very carefully, adhere the inside pieces as shown in the photo... be sure to alternate colors to add interest.
5. Stamp the outer sentiment in the upper corner of this layer using Early Espresso ink.
6. Use SNAIL to adhere this vanilla layer to the Early Espresso layer then use SNAIL to attach the new layer to the card front.
7. Use Early Espresso ink to stamp the inside sentiment on back of the card front.
8. Use Wild Wasabi ink to stamp the leaves on the larger Very Vanilla layer. Use SNAIL to adhere to the inside of the card opposite the sentiment.
