

# Bumblebee Hooray



Made by Joanne Cantrell, Independent Stampin' Up Demonstrator  
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## Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Well Said (148496)
- **Paper:** Bumblebee Cardstock (153077); Basic Gray Cardstock (121044); Whisper White Cardstock (100730)
- **Inks:** Basic Gray Classic Stampin' Pad (149165)
- **Embellishments:** Bumblebee 2020-2022 In Color 1/4" Ribbon (153622)
- **Adhesives:** Dimensionals (104430); Mini Dimensionals (144108); Stampin' Seal (152813); Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)
- **Other:** Well Written Dies (151816); Subtle 3D Embossing Folder (151775); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Paper Trimmer (142392); Paper Snips (103579);

## Measurements:

- **Bumblebee:** 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" card base – portrait (fold at side); 4-3/8" x 3-1/8" layer; 3-3/8" x 2-1/8" layer; scrap ≈ 1" x 1"
- **Basic Gray:** 4-1/2" x 3-1/4" layer; 3-1/2" x 2-1/4" layer
- **Whisper White:** 4" x 3"

Instructions:

1. Cut and score all pieces as outline above.
2. Use the Cut & Emboss Machine and Well Written dies to cut out the branches, "hooray," and a bird from the piece of whisper white. Cut an additional bird from the scrap of Bumblebee.
3. Carefully add thin bit of Tombow Liquid Glue to the back of the sentiment. Attach to the bottom left of the 4-3/8" x 3-1/8" Bumblebee layer so that the "y" hangs off the layer.
4. Carefully add thin bit of Tombow Liquid Glue to the back of the branches and attach them to the center of the 3-3/8" x 2-1/8" Bumblebee layer so that the bottom of the branches is even(ish) with the bottom of the layer and the top leaf hangs past the top of the layer.
5. Place the two Bumblebee layers into the Subtle 3D Embossing Folder and run through the Cut & Emboss Machine using the Specialty Plate. This will add texture to the layers.
6. Use Tombow or Seal to attach the textured layers to the appropriately sized Basic Gray layers.
7. Cut a length of Bumblebee ribbon and tie it around the "hooray" layer just below the middle. Tie it off using knot. Use snips to neatly trim the ends.
8. Use Dimensionals to attach this layer centered on the card front. Then, use Dimensionals to attach the branches layer to the upper right corner of the hooray layer so there is about 1/16" of the bottom layer showing on the edges.
9. Place a Mini Dimensional on the back of the yellow bird and attach him to the card front near the top right of the branches.
10. Use Basic Gray ink to stamp the sentiment on the inside of the card. Use a bit of Seal or Tombow to attach the white bird near the sentiment.

  
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
