## **Cookies Help**

Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Nothing's Better Than ()
- Paper: Very Vanilla Cardstock (); Early Epsresso Cardstock (); Soft Suede Cardstock ()
- Inks: Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad (); Soft Suede Classic Stampin' Pad (); Terracotta Tile Classic Stampin' Pad ()
- Embellishments: Ornate Garden Ribbon Combo Pack (149590)
- Adhesives: Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755) or Stampin' Seal (152813); Dimensionals (104430); Mini Glue Dots (103683)
- **Other:** Love You More Than Dies (152698); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Paper Trimmer (152392); Paper Snips (103579); Stamping Sponges (141337)

Measurements:

- Early Espresso: 8-1/2" x 4-1/4" card base Portrait (scored at 5-1/2"); Scrap ≈ 2" x 1"
- Soft Suede: 8" x 3" scored at 4"; Scrap ≈ 2" x 1"; Scrap ≈ 1-1/2" square (need 2)
- Very Vanilla: 5-1/4" x 4" layer; 4" x 2-3/4" (cut 2); 3-3/4" x 2-3/4" (cut 2); Scrap ≈ 1-1/2" square (need 2)

Instructions:

- 1. Cut and score all pieces as outlined above.
- 2. Create your own DSP-type look by randomly stamping the cookie image one all Very Vanilla layers EXCEPT one of the 3-3/4" x 2-3/4" layers. Use Soft Suede ink and the Stamping Off technique (ink up your stamp and stamp onto a scrap piece of paper first to remove some of the ink... then stamp on the vanilla cardstock). Use this same ink and technique to stamp two cookies on the Very Vanilla scraps.

- 3. Use Terracotta Tile ink to stamp the tiny star image randomly over each layer stamped with the cookies.
- 4. Use the Terracotta Tile ink to stamp stars in the corners of the remaining 3-3/4" x 2-3/4" layers. Use Early Espresso Ink to stamp the sentiment in the center.
- 5. Use the Cut & Emboss Machine and Love You More Than dies to cut out the two stamped cookies, two cookies from the square scraps of Soft Suede, one "cookies" from the Early Espresso scrap and one from the remaining Soft Suede scrap.
- 6. Using Soft Suede ink and a Stamping Sponge wedge, add color to the edges to all layers. Use the wedge to smear a little color over all the layers as well. This will add texture and aging to the card.
- 7. Use Tombow or Seal to attach the layers...
  - The 5-1/4" x 4" layer goes on "inside" of the card base.
  - The 4" x 2-3/4" layers go on each side of the card "front"
  - The 3-3/4" x 2-3/4" layer with the cookies goes on the outside of the little Soft Suede card remember this card opens backward.
  - The 3-3/4" x 2-3/4" layer with the sentiment goes in the inside of the little Soft Suede card.
- 8. Use a wee tiny layer of Tombow glue on the back of the Soft Suede "cookies" and adhere to the center of the litter Soft Suede card front. Remember this card opens backward. Repeat with the Early Espresso "cookies" and adhere on top of the Soft Suede one, offset just a little so it creates a shadow effect.
- 9. Tie a length of ribbon around the front of the little Soft Suede card front and tie it off in a bow. If loose, use a glue dot under the bow knot to hold it in place.
- 10. Use adhesive to attach the little Soft Suede card to the "inside" of the card base. It should be centered on the base layer. Remember this little Soft Suede card opens backward. (I only say that so many times because I need to remind myself of that so I don't put it on upside down! LOL) Once attached, open the little card and close the other card front so they are overlapping.
- 11. Use Tombow or Seal to attach the stamped cookies to the solid cookies, offsetting them a bit to create that shadow effect. Use Dimensionals to attach to the little Soft Suede card front.
