Simple Summer Days

Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Summer Days (152677)
- Paper: Just Jade Cardstock (153079); Sahara Sand Cardstock (121043); Whisper White Cardstock (100730); 2020-2022 In Color 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper (153070)
- Inks: Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad (147114); Old Olive Blends (154892); Bermuda Bay Blends (154878); Crumb Cake Blends (154882); Smoky Slate Blends (154904)
- Embellishments: Flowers for Every Season Ribbon Combo Pack (153620)
- Adhesives: Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755) or Stampin' Seal (152813); Dimensionals (104430)
- Other: Banner Triple Punch (138292)

Measurements:

- Just Jade: 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" card base landscape (scored at top)
- Sahara Sand: 4-1/2" x 3-1/4" layer (cut 2)
- Whisper White: 4-1/4" x 3" layer (cut 2); 3-1/8" x 3/4"
- **DSP:** 3-1/4" x 1"

Instructions:

- 1. Cut and score card base and layers as indicated above. For the Designer Series Paper (DSP), I used the Just Jade pattern with the words.
- 2. Use Early Espresso ink to stamp the images on the Whisper White layers as shown. Use the Blends to color the images as desired.
- 3. Stamp the sentiment on the remaining piece of Whisper White. Use the tiniest wee bit of Seal or Tombow to attach the left side of the sentiment layer to the piece of DSP. Slide this side into the Banner punch to punch the banner notch. The two layers should be separate again. (This is my tip as how to have perfectly punch banners when the top layer is too small for the punch. It works like a dream!) Now, use Seal or Tombow to attach the sentiment layer to the DSP layer so the right sides are aligned. Tie a length of ribbon around the end of the banner into a knot. Trim the ends.
- 4. Attach each stamped and colored Whisper White layer to the Sahara Sand layers. Then, adhere them to the card base using the same adhesive.
- 5. Attach the banner to the upper right corner with Dimensionals.
