



Grateful Frame

Made by Joanne Cantrell, Independent Stampin' Up Demonstrator
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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Celebration Tidings (153456); Beautiful Autumn (153450)
- **Paper:** Cinnamon Cider Cardstock (153078); So Saffron Cardstock (105118); Very Vanilla Cardstock (101650); Pumpkin Pie Cardstock (105117); Old Olive Cardstock (100702)
- **Inks:** Old Olive Classic Stampin' Pad (147090); Cinnamon Cider Classic Stampin' Pad (153114); Pumpkin Pie Classic Stampin' Pad (147086); Old Olive Blends (154892); Pumpkin Pie Blends (154897)
- **Adhesives:** Stampin' Seal (152813); Mini Glue Dots (103683); Foam Adhesive Strips (141825)
- **Punches & Dies:** Autumn Pick a Punch (153609); Stitched Rectangles Dies (151820)
- **Tools:** Paper Trimmer (142392); Paper Snips (103579); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)

Measurements:

- **Cinnamon Cider:** 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" card base – landscape (top-fold); 4-1/4" x 2-3/4" frame
- **So Saffron:** 5-1/4" x 4" layer (cut 2); 3-3/4" x 2-1/2" frame; 1" x 1" scrap
- **Very Vanilla:** 5" x 3-3/4" layer (Cut 2)
- **Pumpkin Pie:** 1" x 1" scrap
- **Old Olive:** 1" x 1" scrap

Instructions:

1. Cut and score all pieces as outline above.
2. From the Stitched Rectangles, you will need the 3-15/16" x 2-5/8", 3-1/2" x 2-1/4", and 3-3/16" x 1-13/16" dies. Use the biggest and the smallest here to cut a frame from the Cinnamon Cider 4-1/4" x 2-3/4" frame piece. Then, use the Middle size and the smallest to cut a frame from the So Saffron 3-3/4" x 2-1/2" frame piece. Use a thin line of Tombow to glue the two frames together centering the inside hole.
3. Use this frame as a guide to stamp the top pumpkin image and the bottom leaves image on one of the Very Vanilla layers using Old Olive ink. Stamp the sentiment between these images in Cinnamon Cider ink. Use the Light Pumpkin Blends to color the pumpkin and the Light Old Olive Blends to color in the leaves.
4. Use Cinnamon Cider ink to stamp the acorn image on the small scrap of Cinnamon Cider cardstock. Use Pumpkin Pie ink to stamp the maple leaf image on the small scrap of Pumpkin Pie cardstock. Use Old Olive ink to stamp the oak leaf image on the Old Olive cardstock. Use the Autumn Punches to punch out each shape. Attach to the bottom left corner of the frame using Mini Glue Dots.
5. Use Old Olive Ink to stamp the bottom leaves image on the remaining Very Vanilla layer. You will flip it over and stamp it centered on the top (this puts the leaves up). Then, stamp it centered on the bottom of the layer.
6. Use Stampin' Seal to adhere the Very Vanilla layers to the So Saffron Layers.
7. Use Stampin' Seal to attach the Very Vanilla/So Saffron layer with the sentiment to the front of the card base. Use Seal to attach the other Very Vanilla/SO Saffron layer to the inside of the card base.
8. Use Foam Adhesive Strip to attach the frame centered over the sentiment on the card front.


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
