



Halloween Pocket Card

Made by Joanne Cantrell, Independent Stampin' Up Demonstrator
Inspired by XXX
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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Hallows Night Magic (153356*)
- **Paper:** Basic Black Cardstock (121045); Cajun Craze Cardstock (119684); Gray Granite Cardstock (146983); (Pretty Peacock Cardstock (150880); Blackberry Bliss Cardstock (133675); Magic in this Night Designer Series Paper (153517)
- **Inks:** Memento Pad (132708); Pretty Peacock Classic Stampin' Pad (1500083); VersaMark Pad (102283)
- **Adhesives:** Black Dimensionals (150893); Stampin' Seal (152813); Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755)
- **Punches & Dies:** Halloween Magic Dies (153565*); Cobwebs 3D Embossing Folder (153578)
- **Tools:** Paper Trimmer (152392); Paper Snips (103579); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Heat Tool (129053); Clear Embossing Powder (109130); Stampin' Sponges (141337)

Measurements:

- **Basic Black:** 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" scored at 4-1/2" on long side; 3-1/2" x 5" bats and spider
- **Cajun Craze:** 5-1/4" x 4" layer; 5-1/4" x 2" layer; 2" x 1-1/4" flower
- **Gray Granite:** 3-1/2" x 2" sentiment; 5" x 3-3/4" layer
- **Pretty Peacock:** 4-1/2" x 3" layer; 1" x 1-1/2" petals (cut 2)
- **Blackberry Bliss:** 2" x 1-1/4" flower
- **DSP 1:** 5" x 1-3/4" layer
- **DSP 2:** 5" x 2" layer

Instructions:

1. Cut and score all pieces as outline above.
2. Use a Stampin Sponge wedge (cut a whole sponge into 6 to 8 pieces) and Memento ink to lightly add black ink to the edges of all the layers that will not be die cut to make it look aged (see the photo).
3. Use VersaMark ink to stamp the Bats and the Spider images on the 3-1/2" x 5" piece of Basic Black cardstock. Sprinkle liberally with Clear Embossing Powder. Tap off extra powder. Use heat gun to set the powder. Use the dies to cut out the bats and spider.
4. Use the flower die to cut a Cajun Craze and Blackberry Bliss flower from the 2" x 1-1/4" pieces. Use the petal die to cut two petals from the 1" x 1-1/2" pieces. Sponge Memento ink to the flowers and petals. Attach the petals to the flowers using a tiny bit of Tombow glue.
5. Use the large frame die to cut the frame from the 4-1/2" x 3" piece of Pretty Peacock cardstock. Use the Cobwebs embossing folder to add the spider web texture to the layer. Use a Stampin Sponge wedge (cut a whole sponge into 6 to 8 pieces) and Memento ink to add black ink to the edge and spiderwebs to make it look aged.
6. Use Memento ink to stamp the frame image onto the small Gray Granite layer. Stamp the sentiment in Pretty Peacock ink. Use the small frame die to cut out the sentiment frame. Use the Stampin' Sponge wedge to apply black ink the layer. Use Dimensionals to attach the sentiment to the Pretty Peacock frame.
7. Use Stampin' Seal to adhere the 5" x 1-3/4" piece of DSP to the 5-1/4" x 2" piece of Cajun Craze. Use Seal to adhere to the small flap on the card front.
8. Use Memento ink to stamp a couple spiders onto the larger Gray Granite layer. Use Stampin' Seal to attach this layer to the large Cajun Craze layer. Use Stampin' Seal to attach the large Cajun Craze layer to the inside of the card base. Apply Seal to the sides and bottom only of the other piece of DSP. This will create a pocket for a gift card, etc. Adhere this to the bottom of the Gray Granite layer.
9. Use Dimensionals to attach the sentiment frames to the flap of the card front.
10. Use Dimensionals to attach the small bat to the bottom of the card so that the tip of its wing holds the sentiment layer closed.
11. Use Dimensionals to attach the other pieces to the card front as shown in the photo. You may have to cut the mini Dimensionals in half for the flowers so they are hidden on the thicker middle part.




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
