Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Nature's Beauty (150528); Many Mates (152633)
- Paper: Early Espresso Cardstock (119686); Soft Suede Cardstock (115318); Very Vanilla Cardstock (101650)
- Inks: Early Espresso Classic Stampin' Pad (147114)
- Embellishments: Linen Thread (104199)
- Adhesives: Tombow Multipurpose Liquid Adhesive (138309) or Stampin' Seal Adhesive (152813);
 Dimensionals (104430)

Measurements:

- Early Espresso: 5-1/2" x 4-1/4" card base portrait (scored on side)
- Soft Suede: 4-1/2" x 3-1/4" layer (cut 2)
- Very Vanilla: 4-1/4" x 3" layer (cut 2); 1" x 4-1/4" layer; scrap ≈ 3" x 1-1/2"

Instructions:

- 1. Cut and score card base and layers as indicated above.
- 2. Stamp all images and sentiments using Early Espresso ink.
 - Stamp small sapling image across the front of the card base about 2" up from the bottom.
 - Stamp the deer image centered on one of the larger Very Vanilla layers
 - Stamp the sapling image on either side of the deer as well as in the bottom corner of the other Very Vanilla layer of the same size.
 - Stamp the grass image along the bottom of both layers
 - Stamp the deer image on the scrap piece of Very Vanilla.
 - Stamp the outside sentiment on the 1" x 4-1/4" Very Vanilla layer.
 - Stamp the interior sentiment on the inside Vanilla layer.
- 3. Use Tombow or SEAL adhesive to attach each of the larger Very Vanilla layers to the Soft Suede layers. Use the same adhesive to attach the layers to the card base.
- 4. Cut two 11"-12" lengths of Linen Thread. Wrap one piece of the thread around the end of the outside sentiment layer about 1/2" from the edge. Tie it in a knot and trim the ends even. Repeat with the other piece of thread on the other end of the layer. Attach this layer to the front of the card using Dimensionals.
- 5. Using Paper Snips, cut the deer image from the scrap of Vanilla. Attach over the deer on the card frot using Dimensionals.
